Remodel of the west wing of two patient room floors, consisting of complete renovation of the entire interior in 9,600 square feet of the South Tower. Patient rooms on the 8th floor were converted to VIP status, with upgraded finishes. Scope of work included total replacement of the nurses stations on both floors and complete renovation of the existing 8th floor Galley. Work was accomplished while adjacent patient room areas remained in use.



Cedars-Sinai Medical Center Linear Accelerator

Miles & Kelley completed the replacement of an existing linear accelerator (Varian Clinac 6) with the newer Varian Truebeam System. New concrete footings were required, and extensive additions were made to the existing shielding, including structural steel supports for new lead shielding and additional shielding at the vault ceiling, consisting of layered lead and steel. In addition, support spaces were renovated to accommodate the new equipment, in a single phase project located on the lower level of the North Patient Tower. The existing utility tunnel required shoring along equipment delivery path to protect the existing structure during the delivery and rigging process.
